Palazzo del Mare, <i>Rallo, Italy</i>	£4.85	£6.85	£20.50
Fresh & crisp with a hint saltiness from the salt plains of Sicily this is an extremely drinkable house wine.			
Ladera Verde Sauvignon Blanc, <i>Nancagua, Chile</i>	£5.50	£7.85	£23.50
Grapefruit and cut grass on the nose, supple and fruity with refreshing acidity. A classic Sauvignon Blanc.			
Tai Pinot Grigio, <i>Capriano, Italy</i>	£5.90	£8.35	£25.00
Floral, honeyed aromas, lively and fresh. Delicious aperitif.			
Coleridge Hill, <i>Three Choirs, England</i>	£6.25	£8.85	£26.50
Orchard fruits, nettles and cut grass on the nose, lovely green apple fruit on the palate. A taste of the British summer!			
Ardeche Chardonnay, <i>Vinerons Ardechois, Ardeche, France</i>	£6.75	£9.50	£28.50
Buttery with judicious use of oak. Medium bodied with great balance and a long finish.			
Saumur Blanc, <i>Cave de Saumur, Loire, France</i>			£29.50
Chenin blanc is the grape here - a great example with delicious green apple characters and lively acidity. A great food wine that would work everything from subtle fish dishes to roast pork.			
Muscadet Chereau 2017, <i>Loire, France</i>			£30.00
The Muscadet wine itself has a pale colour, slightly saline 'sea breeze' scents and a life-enhancing acidity, having over-wintered on its fine lees before bottling, which imparts a subtle prickle of carbon dioxide.			
Mayfly Sauvignon Blanc, <i>Zephyr, New Zealand</i>	£7.50	£10.50	£31.50
Fresh and crisp Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with a nose of fresh asparagus, and tropical fruits such as peach and lychee. On the palate it is vibrant and fresh with balanced natural acidity, well rounded and good structure.			
Rheinhessen Riesling 2013, <i>Staatliche Weinbaudomane Oppenheim, Germany</i>	£7.75	£10.85	£32.50
Germany is the spiritual home of the Riesling grape variety which, like Pinot Noir, flourishes in the cooler climate. This is a textbook example - lime leaf aromas backed by a whistle-clean, mineral-edged palate of orchard fruit.

Pinot Blanc 2015, Leon Beyer, Alsace, France

£36.50

A full-bodied aromatic Alsace Pinot Blanc. It is a fleshy wine, with notes of apple, perfect with spicy cuisine.

Pouilly Fume Les Loges 2016, Dominique Guyot, Loire, France

£42.50

Dominique Guyot's Pouilly Fumé wine has a bouquet of gooseberries and gun-flint and a fresh, zesty, mineral-edged palate with a persistent, dry finish.

Albarino, Seniorias, Spain

£45.50

Peachy white stone fruit, lovely weight in the mouth with flinty notes. Great length and the perfect partner to seafood.

Chablis 2016, Camu, Burgundy, France

£46.50

Made from pure Chardonnay grown on free-draining, calciferous soil, it has a limpid, golden-green hue, green apple aromas and fresh, fruit-laden palate underscored by a nervy minerality.

Sancerre, Andre Vatan, Loire, France

£11.50 £16.25 £48.50

Sancerre 'Les Perriers' from André Vatan is a benchmark white Sancerre wine - pure Sauvignon Blanc, with a classic elderflower bouquet and a lean, zesty palate.

Forest Hill Chardonnay, Forest Hill, Australia

Bright straw with green hues and aromas of white nectarine & citrus peel. Flavours of stonefruit persist on the palate with citrus. Barrel fermentation builds richness, texture and complexing nutty flavours. Finish is long with natural acidity.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Pere Caboché, Rhone, France

£57.00

This Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc is blended from a base of 40% Roussanne with 20% each of Grenache Blanc, Bourboulenc and Clairette. It has appealing agrume aromas and a zesty palate of peach and apricot flavours with an elegant, dry finish.

Meursault, Stephane Brochard, Burgundy, France

£90.00

Opulent apple fruit combined with a mineral elegance, and a hint of toasted nut, and subtle, oaky overtones, this alluring Meursault wine is drinking well now, but will last for ten years or more.

Bursting with cherry and ripe, red berry fruits interwined with pepper and a touch of coffee bean. Elegant and medium bodied, this is an easy pleasing all-rounder, delicious with pasta, ham and cheese.			
Cotes du Rhone R 2016, <i>Vignerons Ardechois, Rhone, France</i>	£6.25	£8.85	£26.50
A classic Grenache/Syrah blend by a forward-thinking cave co-operative in the Ardèche. It's soft, smooth, supple, peppery and pretty much the perfect, gluggable example from this popular region!

Made from pure Cabernet Franc, this Saumur rouge is savoury and youthful with bright, summer berry scents and flavours and can be drunk lightly chilled.			
Barbera d'Asti 'La Villa', <i>Olim Bauda, Italy</i>			£35.00
Small production made meticulously using generations' worth of family knowledge. Barbera in its raw state - deep, concentrated and spicy but not without purity and elegance.

This precocious 'Petit Château' has alluring red berry aromas preceding a palate with a wealth of cassis flavours, great concentration and fine balance.			
Pinot Noir, <i>Zephyr, New Zealand</i>			£40.00
Bright aromas of raspberries, wild forest berry fruits with cedar and spice. On the palate, rich and vibrant with primary notes of cherry, currants and wonderfully grainy french oak. Crozes Hermitage 2015, <i>Pascal Freres, Rhone, France</i>			£41.00
With classic Syrah farmyard and saddle leather aromas preceding a palate of dark, brambly fruit offset by firm, well-integrated tannins, this can't fail to please when matched with some good quality red meat!			
Cabernet Sauvignon, <i>Forest Hill, Australia</i>			£46.00
A dark red, medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon from Western Australia that displays blackcurrant, liquorice and chocolate flavours. An ideal match for roasts.			
Marsannay Vieilles Vignes 2015, <i>Brocard, Burgundy, France</i>			£63.00
A wine of undoubted class! Intensely aromatic with wild berries and gun smoke filling the glass. Medium bodied, elegant tannins with perfectly balanced acidity. Drinks like a dream!

Pol Roger NV, <i>Pol Roger, Reims, France</i> From a family-owned firm established over 150 years ago with 175 acres of prime vineyards around Epernay. An elegant champagne with aromas of brioche. Dry with apples and minerals, finesse and poise on the palate.		£85.00
Dom Perignon 2004, <i>Moët & Chandon, Reims, France</i> This is a top cuvée from one of Champagne's most revered and renowned historic houses. Each vintage is a perfectly balanced blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, aged for a minimum of seven years. 2009 was an excellent vintage that, while still youthful, is showing great elegance. Exemplary in style, depth and quality, this is simply heavenly.		£190.00
